







## **THE Christmas Workshop 2023**

University of Hohenheim December 7 and 8, 2023

The **Tübingen-Hohenheim-Economics (THE) Association** cordially invites you to this year's **THE Christmas Workshop** combining a **Young Researcher Workshop** and a **Mini Course**.

Young Researcher Workshop: PhD students, post-docs, and assistant professors will present ongoing research from all areas of Economics, Econometrics, and Economic History and receive feedback from senior researchers. Presentation slots as well as poster sessions will be available. There will also be a Best Paper Award. We welcome submissions in the form of (preferably) papers or extended abstracts until November 6, 2023 via email to <a href="mailto:intecon@uni-hohenheim.de">intecon@uni-hohenheim.de</a>. Accepted papers will be assigned to a discussant (senior researcher). The Young Researcher Workshop is an integral part of the Doctoral Study Program Economics at the University of Hohenheim.

Mini Course: Andreas Moxnes, Professor of Economics at the University of Oslo, will give a short course (3 units á 90min) on Endogenous Formation of Networks in Economics. More precisely, the course will cover the latest developments in the empirical and theoretical literature on production networks and focus on three main topics: (i) Stylized facts on the structure of production networks; (ii) Consequences of production networks: Why a networks perspective is crucial for the analysis of economic growth, productivity and trade; (iii) The formation of production network: Which firms succeed and grow and which ones fail? Each participant of the Mini Course is expected to contribute 100 EUR towards expenses. In exceptional cases, the contribution can be waived (upon request). The **tentative schedule** of the workshop is as follows: The event will open on **Thursday** at 9:00 a.m. with two units of the Mini Course, to be followed by the Young Researcher Workshop after lunch (approx. 1:30 p.m.). On **Friday**, we will start at 9:00 a.m. with the third unit of the Mini Course and continue with the Workshop from 10:30 a.m. We plan to close the workshop on Friday after the Best Paper Award ceremony at approx. 4:30 p.m. We cordially invite all participants and discussants to join in for the **workshop dinner** on Thursday at 6:30 p.m. (at own expense). The detailed program will be sent to registered participants via email in due time.
